TOPIC: From Explorers to Educators in the Colca Region of Peru



Mr. Andrzej Andrew Pi towski

Andrew graduated from University of Mining and Metallurgy AGH (Krakow, Poland) – Electronics; and Bowling Green State University of Ohio – M.A. in Mathematics.

Kayaker, traveler, discoverer, educator, leader of the longest non-sailing kayak expedition "Canoandes' 79-81", and leader of the National Geographic Society's expedition "Amazon 2000" which pinpointed and confirmed the farthest source of the Oueen of the Rivers with mathematical accuracy.

- Founder and president of The Eng. Ernest Malinowski Polish-American Educational Foundation, Inc., a longtime foundation supporting activists of Polonia in the USA.
- Awarded the "Cross of Merit" by president of Poland for "the promotion of Poland in the world". Fellow National member of the prestigious Explorer Club in New York.
- Dreamer, altruist, always in love with Peru.

After five years of teaching mathematics in Nigeria and Bolivia, Andrew returned to Chicago and is sharing his time between family life, Polonia activities (member of Polish American Congress) and summer schools of English language in the Colca Valley, organized yearly since 2004. Currently, he is working on the creation of a Polish Home and Linguistic Institute near the Colca Canyon in Peru and on translating of his book, "To Conquer Colca Canyon and mountain rivers in Americas" (in Polish, edit. Bezdroza, 2013), into Spanish and English. He is also looking for sponsors and associates which would be interested in both of Andrew's ambitious endeavors. Married, one son Sebastien.

ABSTRACT

Andrew will take us to the world deepest land gorge, the Colca Canyon in southern Peru, discovered in 1981 by the kayakers from Krakow. After the young polish students discovered it, they promoted it as a tourism attraction. This profoundly changed the life of two native tribes, called Collagua and Cabana, populating the Colca Valley.


Today, over 200,000 tourists are visiting the enchanting Colca Canyon and have left behind over US\$ 4 million in profits and an incredible impact on the native culture. To improve the relationship between tourists and locals, Andrew is now trying to help native youth to communicate with those foreign visitors by teaching English in public schools and evening classes. He has been spending his summers there since 2004, accompanied by volunteers, doing this. Additionally, every summer, Andrew and the volunteers gather some poor students and work with them using audio-visual methods to make them more communicative to help them get employment and a better pay within the tourism industry in their town.

Old footage of the Colca discovery in 1981 and super slides from the Colca Canyon and nearby source of the Amazon River at Nevado Mismi, as well as glimpses of the "fifth world" societies of Nigeria will take us to remote and abandoned places on two continents.
