TOPIC:	New Orleans Hurricane Protection System Restoration

Repairing the extensive damage to New Orleans' hurricane and flood protection system caused by the devastating winds and flood waters generated by Hurricane Katrina was high priority for the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). The initial rebuilding goal of bringing the levees and floodwalls back to pre-Katrina protection levels in time for the June 1, 2006 hurricane season has recently been accomplished by Task Force Guardian. Stanley Consultants provided Quality Control and Management Support to facilitate the work of the task force. This presentation covers the planning, management and execution of the rapid response required to address the monumental engineering challenges. Photographs of the damage and reconstruction efforts are included.
