Mr. Krystian Gebis is co-founder and CEO of Autobon AI, a (2018) Techstars Mobility-backed company building a selfdriving autopilot system for semi-trucks. Mr. Gebis graduated in 2016 from the University of Illinois at Chicago, with a B.S. in Computer Engineering, and a focus on Autonomous Navigation and Computer Vision.

While in school, Mr. Gebis already began working as a Software Engineer at Auro Robotics, creating a Robotic Operating System Package that integrates with Open Street Maps to generate both 2D and 3D road maps; as well as Head of Software Engineering at Chicago EDT Robotics, developing the software

for an entire in-housed robot called Scipio, for the international 'Intelligent Ground Vehicle Competition' (which won 3rd Place out of 40+ universities). Also while in school, in 2016, Mr. Gebis co-founded Autobon, AI.
