Bartlomiej Bobek is a staff metallurgical engineer with nine years of experience at SGS MSI Testing and Engineering, Inc., independent metallurgical testing and consulting laboratory located in Melrose Park, Illinois. As a metallurgical engineer and American Welding Society Certified Welding Inspector (AWS CWI) he is responsible for testing and analysis of the production and test weldments. Bartlomiej Bobek holds a Master of Science in Materials Engineering and Metallurgy from the Academy of Mining and Metallurgy, Krakow (2004).

ABSTRACT

The presentation covers principles and applications of nondestructive testing techniques in modern quality control. It will be shown how simple visual checks and sophisticated, digitally processed ultrasonic and X-ray signals are critical for production or maintenance in almost all industry branches.


